

Guitar Syllabus: 6-Month Course

Month 1: Foundations & Basic Techniques

Objective: Develop finger strength, coordination, and understanding of basic chords.

- Guitar anatomy, tuning, posture, and picking techniques.
- Basic open chords: C, G, D, A, E, Am, Em, Dm.
